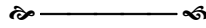

6 March 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 4pm. ²
15 February 1850	Charged at Brickfields Hiring Depot with being drunk; sentence 2m HL, Cascades FF. ³
12 October 1850	Tried at Clarence Plains PC charged by her master George Kemp, Kangaroo Point with disobedience of orders on 11 October; sentence 3m HL, Cascades FF, to be returned. ⁴
8 April 1851	Tried at Hobart PC charged with absence without leave from the service of John Symons, Warwick St, Hobart the whole of the night of 6 April; sentence 2m HL, Cascades FF, recommended she may be hired in the interior. ⁵
14 April 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with disobedience of regulations; sentence 2d SC & 14d separate treatment. ⁶
23 April 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with talking at exercise; sentence 2d SC. ⁶
21 May 1851	Sponsor at baptism of Joseph Murphy, son of Catherine Murphy (<i>qv</i>), at Hobart. ⁷
16 June 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with talking at mess table; reprimanded. ⁶
29 October 1851	Charged by her master George Reggett, <i>Tasmanian Lass</i> , Hamilton with neglect of duty; sentence 1m HL, Cascades FF. ³
22 November 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with disorderly conduct and using improper language; sentence 7d cleaning the yards. ⁶
20 December 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with leaving her work; sentence 10d cleaning the yards. ⁶
27 January 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ³
12 February 1852	To Henric Nicholas, <i>Cawood</i> , River Ouse. ³
4 March 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ³
15 March 1852	To Launceston. ³
16 March 1852	To E Reilly, Launceston. ³
4 May 1852	To Launceston FF, then to Alfred Locke, Launceston. ³
5 July 1852	Charged by her master Alfred Locke with being absent without leave; sentence 14d SC, Launceston FF. ³
19 July 1852	To Alfred Locke, Launceston. ³

^b Age given as 30y on Grangegorman prison register.

2 August 1852	Charged by her master Alfred Locke with being absent without leave; sentence 2m HL. ³
28 September 1852	To William Ashburner, Westbury. ³
2 March 1853	To Launceston FF. ³
3 March 1853	To R Reaby, Launceston. ³
5 March 1853	To Launceston FF, then to Henry G Reid, West Tamar. ³
17 June 1853	Application for permission to marry Nathaniel Bramich, free (approved 23 June). ⁸
16 January 1859	Free by servitude.
7 October 1859	Certificate of Freedom collected at Launceston. ³
