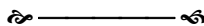

24 February 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 10:30am. <sup>2</sup>
10 September 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for scorbutus (off 22 September, cured). <sup>3</sup>
1850	Mustered in Glamorgan district, in service to William Lyne. <sup>4</sup>
16 August 1850	Contracted as PPH to Joseph Bedgegood, Waubs Bay, Bicheno, 12m at £9 pa. <sup>5</sup>
1851	Mustered in Glamorgan district, in service to William Lyne. <sup>6</sup>
23 September 1851	Application for permission to marry John Board, FS ( <i>David Clarke</i> ) (approved 30 September). <sup>7</sup>
5 November 1851	<b>Married</b> as 35y, spinster, to John Board, 33y, shoemaker, at All Saints CE Church, Swansea; witnesses Richard Wilshire & Elizabeth Simms. <sup>8</sup>
1852	Mustered in Glamorgan district, in service to William Lyne. <sup>9</sup>
5 February 1852	To apply in 4 months for Ticket-of-Leave. <sup>10</sup>
8 June 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. <sup>10</sup>
12 August 1852	Husband John Board granted Conditional Pardon. <sup>11</sup>
18 August 1853	<b>Son</b> Thomas Board, shoemaker's child, born at <i>Apslawn</i> near Cranbrook. <sup>12</sup>
12 December 1855	Husband John Board received Certificate of Freedom. <sup>11</sup>
8 January 1856	Free by servitude.
27 March 1857	Certificate of Freedom at Bicheno for collection. <sup>10</sup>
1858	Husband John Board occupier of house & land (3 acres) at Apsley River. <sup>13</sup>
23 December 1878	Son Thomas Board married Bridget Cooper <sup>b</sup> at the dwelling house of John Board, Apsley. <sup>14</sup>
7 December 1898	Son Thomas Board, 46y, farmer, died of inflammation of the lungs at Llandaff near <i>Apslawn</i> . <sup>15</sup>
11 December 1898	<b>Died</b> of decay of nature at Llandaff, 85y, farmer's wife. <sup>16</sup>
20 December 1898	Husband John Board, 80y, shoemaker, died of influenza at <i>Apsley Vale</i> near Llandaff. <sup>17</sup>

<sup>b</sup> Bridget was the daughter of George Cooper and Bridget Scanlon (*qv*). This was her second marriage.
