7 October 1848	Sister Margaret Quealy arrived at Hobart, prisoner on the <i>Kinnear 2</i> , transported for 10 years for sheep stealing. ²
27 March 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 10pm. ³
9 August 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for obstipation (off 25 August, cured). ⁴
25 June 1850	Contracted as PPH to Joseph Freeman, New Wharf, Hobart, 12m at £8 pa. ⁵
June 1850	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ⁶
15 August 1850	Contracted as PPH to Robert William Carns, New Town, 12m at £9 pa. ⁷
29 August 1850	Contracted as PPH to James Callon, Murray St, Hobart, 12m at £8 pa. ⁷
10/16 October 1850	Charged with smoking while employed as night watch at Brickfields Hiring Depot, severely reprimanded. ⁶
20 February 1851	Application for permission to marry Bernard Gallagher (<i>Ratcliffe 1</i>); referred 1 March to woman (approved 18 March). ⁸
7 April 1851	Married as 20y, ^h servant, spinster, to Bernard Gallagher, 21y, baker, bachelor, at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; witnesses William Gale Lambert & Margaret Quealy. ⁹
1851	Mustered in Glamorgan district, in service to husband, Swansea. ¹⁰
13 January 1852	Son Patrick Joseph Gallagher born in Ross district; baptised 29 April 1852 RC at Ross; sponsors Michael Clune & Margaret Quealy. ¹¹

^b Anne stated her mother's name as Mary Butler.

^c Age given as 17y on *Australasia* sick list.

^d This may have been John Butler, 23y, tried at Co. Clare 13 July 1847 for sheep stealing, transported for 7 years on the *Pestonjee Bomanjee*. Alternatively, it could have been John Keane, tried 14 January 1848 at Co. Clare for sheep stealing, sentenced to 10 years' transportation, but detained at Smithfield Gaol, Co. Dublin. If it was the latter, then he was tried with his brother Patrick and sister Margaret.

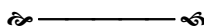
^e This was possibly Patrick Kennerk, tried 14 January 1848 at Co. Clare for sheep stealing, sentenced to 10 years' transportation but died in Smithfield Gaol, Co. Dublin on 16 January 1849.

^f Name given as Mary on Grangegorman record.

^g Her father was not noted on her indent, so he was probably dead when Anne and her mother were transported. This information was provided on Anne's death certificate. His occupation was given as farmer.

^h Age at marriage given as 16y on death certificate.

30 March 1852	Husband Bernard Gallagher granted Conditional Pardon. ¹²
30 April 1852	Witness with husband Bernard Gallagher at marriage of sister Margaret Quealy to Michael Clune (<i>Cadet</i>) at Ross. ¹³
1852	Mustered in Glamorgan district, in service to husband. ¹⁰
31 August 1852	Mustered in Swansea district. ⁶
26 October 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁶
11 January 1853	Mustered in Swansea district. ⁶
1 February 1853	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ⁶
28 July 1853	Son Bernard Gallagher, ⁱ labourer's child, born at <i>Riversdale</i> , near Swansea; baptised 30 October at Great Swan Port in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors Thomas Kelly & Mary Kelly. ¹⁴
7 February 1854	Conditional Pardon approved. ⁶
4 January 1855	Son John Gallagher, baker's child, born at Jerusalem; baptised 27 January at Jerusalem in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors Daniel O'Brien & Sarah Baynton (nee Williams, <i>qv</i>). ¹⁵
27 February 1856	Free by servitude; Certificate of Freedom issued. ⁶
29 April 1857	Husband Bernard Gallagher received Certificate of Freedom at Hobart. ¹²
21 November 1857 ⁱ	Son Michael Gallagher, labourer's child, born in Glamorgan district; baptised 20 December in St Marys district; sponsors Richard Rooney & Ellen Stafford. ¹⁶
1858	Husband Bernard Gallagher occupier of a farm (40 acres) at <i>Riversdale</i> , Glamorgan district. ¹⁷
19 October 1859 ^k	Son James Gallagher, farmer's child, born at Little Plains; baptised 15 April 1860 in St Marys district; sponsors Patrick Foye & Mary Foye. ¹⁸
24 December 1861	Daughter Bridget Gallagher, ^l farmer's child, born at <i>Riversdale</i> near Swansea. ¹⁹
July 1862	Husband Bernard Gallagher, farm labourer, deserted. ²⁰
28 July 1862	Husband Bernard Gallagher, farmer of Swansea, lodged petition for insolvency. ²¹
9 August 1862	Insolvency case (1 st meeting) for husband Bernard Gallagher heard at Court of Requests, Hobart (2 nd meeting 20 August, 3 rd meeting 23 August, 4 th meeting 25 August). ²²
4 July 1863	Application for children James Gallagher, 3y, John Gallagher, 8y, Michael Gallagher, 6y, & Patrick Joseph Gallagher, 11y, to be admitted to Queen's Orphanage, New Town. ²⁰
13 July 1863	Husband Bernard Gallagher located; children not sent to orphanage. ²⁰
c1863	Moved with family to NSW. ²⁷
1879	Son John Gallagher married Sarah Sanders at Glen Innes, NSW. ²³
1880	Son Patrick Joseph Gallagher married Eliza Fitzpatrick at Glen Innes, NSW. ²⁶
1 May 1882	Son James Gallagher married Cecilia Sarah Cox at Brisbane, QLD. ²⁴
1884	Daughter Bridget Gallagher married John Sweeney at Glen Innes, NSW. ²⁵
17 October 1885	Daughter Bridget Gallagher, 23y 9m 6d, died of pneumonia at Meade St, Glen Innes, NSW; buried 19 October in RC cemetery, Glen Innes, NSW. ²⁵
13 September 1891	Son Patrick Joseph Gallagher, 39y, died of pneumonia at Bourke St, Glen Innes, NSW; buried 16 September in RC cemetery, Glen Innes, NSW. ²⁶
21 August 1905	Died of chronic bronchitis & cardiac failure at Glen Innes, NSW, 70y; buried 23 August in RC cemetery, Glen Innes, NSW. ²⁷
