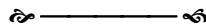
16 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 10am. ²
10 July 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for fever (off 18 July, cured). ³
2 August 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for fever (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³
16 November 1849	Charged with refusing to attend the teaching of the RC catechism, etc on the <i>Anson</i> ; sentence 7d SC. ⁴
13 May 1850	Contracted as PPH to Lawrence Costine, Liverpool St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. ⁵
6 December 1850	Tried at Hobart PC charged with absence without leave from the service of Neil Lewis, Argyle St, Hobart from the afternoon of 4 December until 7am on 6 December when apprehended; sentence 3m HL, Cascades FF, recommended to be hired in the country being a country servant. ⁶
15 April 1851	Contracted as PPH to Robert Edwards, Three Hut Point, 12m at £9 pa. ⁵
28 November 1851	Contracted as PPH to John Green, Campbell Town, 12m at £8 pa. ⁷
5 January 1852	To Ross FF, then to John Presnell, Ross. ⁴
16 January 1852	Tried at Campbell Town PC, brought up from 12 January on remand, charged by John Green with being absent from John Presnell's service without leave & found in John Green's stable on Saturday night 10 January; sentence 9m HL, Ross FF. ⁸
4 February 1852	Charged at Ross FF with idleness & neglect of work; sentence 7d SC. ⁴
24 February 1852	Charged at Ross FF with feigning sickness; sentence 2m HL, Ross FF, to be cumulative, etc. ⁴
3 April 1852	Charged at Ross FF; existing sentence with HL extended 1m. ⁴
14 October 1852	To John Rigney, <i>Ellerslie</i> , Campbell Town. ⁴
7 December 1852	Application for permission to marry William Cowley, FS (<i>HMS Tortoise</i>). ⁹
14 February 1853	Married as 27y, spinster, to William Cowley, 37y, bachelor, at St Luke's CE Church, Campbell Town; witnesses Hugh Burns & Ellen Foster. ¹⁰
c1853	Son John Cowley born. ²⁰
9 July 1855	Daughter Emily Ellen Cowley born at <i>Clarendon</i> . ¹¹
10 June 1856	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁴
6 November 1857	Daughter Mary Ann Cowley born in Morven district. ¹²

29 June 1858	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ⁴
17 May 1859	Conditional Pardon approved (taken up 30 June 1864). ⁴
c1862	Daughter Charlotte Cowley born. ¹³
c1864	Daughter Louise Cowley born. ¹⁴
c1866	Son William Cowley born. ¹⁴
10 June 1867	Husband William Cowley bought land (1 rood 5 perches) at <i>Millwood Plains</i> near White Hills for £10 from James Stevenson. ¹⁵
24 March 1868	Son Arthur Archibald Cowley born at White Hills. ¹⁶
17 May 1869	Husband William Cowley tried at Evandale PC charged with driving a dray without having a lamp lighted when carried on the right or off side of said vehicle; fined 5s & costs 8/6, fine paid. ¹⁷
26 May 1871	Husband William Cowley tried at Longford PC, brought up from 22 May, charged with having on 20 May at Longford committed larceny under £10 in feloniously stealing a dress, value 30s, & a skirt, value 5s, the goods & chattels of Jane Smith; discharged. ¹⁸
12 October 1872	Daughter Emily Ellen Cowley married William Ling in Chalmers Presbyterian Manse, Launceston. ¹⁹
26 February 1875	Husband William Cowley tried at Evandale PC with George Kerr & John Ryan charged by Thomas Peck with trespass; charge withdrawn at request of complainant. ¹⁷
15 December 1875	Husband William Cowley tried at Evandale PC; remanded till 22 nd instant.
27 December 1875	Son John Cowley married Matilda S Challis at Frederick St, Launceston. ²⁰
29 December 1875	Husband William Cowley tried at Evandale PC, brought up from 15 December on remand, charged by John Littlejohn with being an absent servant; case dismissed. ¹⁷
1 May 1876	Husband William Cowley tried at Evandale PC with William Barrenger charged with discharging firearms on the Lord's day; fined 10s & costs 7/6 each, fine paid. ¹⁷
3 October 1876	Daughter Mary Ann Cowley married George Henry Cooper at Chalmers Presbyterian Manse, Launceston. ²¹
24 December 1877	Daughter Charlotte Cowley married William Henry Challis at Chalmers Presbyterian Manse, Launceston. ²²
5 May 1884	Tried at Evandale PC charged with being drunk & disorderly; fined 5s, fine paid. ²³
8 July 1886	Husband William Cowley, 73y, died of enlargement of the liver & heart disease at White Hills. ²⁴
7 May 1890	Son Arthur Archibald Cowley married Emily Mary Gee at Canning St, Launceston. ²⁵
16 May 1899	Sold land (1 rood 5 perches) at <i>Millwood Plains</i> near White Hills for £25 to Maria Stevenson. ²⁶
2 July 1901	Son Arthur Archibald Cowley married ^d Mary Elizabeth Ellen Chugg at <i>Corra Linn</i> , White Hills. ²⁷
4 May 1906	Died at Ellendale, 85y, widow; buried in St Peter's CE Church Cemetery, Hamilton. ²⁸
