| 20 August 1849 | Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for luxation (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³ |
| 20 May 1851 | Application for permission to marry George Lovell (<i>Maria Somes</i> 2) (approved 27 May). ⁴ |
| 28 June 1851 | Married as full age, spinster, to George Lovell, full age, farm labourer, bachelor, at St John the Baptist CE Church, Prossers Plains; witnesses Ellen Price & Robert Blackman. ⁵ |
| 3 July 1851 | Husband George Lovell charged by Olding, Buckland with misconduct in allowing a prisoner to be in his hut after hours; sentence 48h SC. ⁶ |
| 19 July 1851 | Husband George Lovell charged by Olding, Buckland with larceny under £5; sentence 18m HL. ⁶ |
| 25 July 1851 | Husband George Lovell's Ticket-of-Leave revoked. ⁶ |
| 11 September 1851 | Charged by her master Olding ^c with being absent without leave & disobedience of orders; sentence 10d SC. ⁷ |
| 25 September 1851 | Charged by her master Olding with being absent without leave; sentence 4m HL, Cascades FF. ⁷ |
| 25 November 1851 | Charged at Cascades FF with loud talking; sentence 7d cleaning the yards. ⁸ |
| 30 December 1851 | Charged at Cascades FF with Ann Donnolly 2 nd (<i>qv</i>) with leaving her work; admonished. ⁸ |
| 21 January 1852 | To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ⁷ |
| 23 January 1852 | To Captain TS Downes, Kelly St, Hobart. ⁷ |
| 21 February 1852 | Husband George Lovell charged at Salt Water River with disobedience of orders; sentence 9m HL cumulative commencing at expiration of existing sentence. ⁶ |
| 27 March 1852 | To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ⁷ |
| 29 March 1852 | To John Swain, Barrack St, Hobart. ⁷ |
| 26 April 1852 | To Brickfields Hiring Depot, then to John Webb, Murray St, Hobart. ⁷ |
| 26 October 1852 | Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁷ |

^b Age given as: 21y on Grangegorman prison register; 22y on *Australasia* sick list; 26y on description list.

^c This could have been Alfred, John or Willoughby Olding who all had land at Prossers Plains.

| 23 February 1853 | Husband George Lovell charged at Cascades with misconduct in having a penknife & comb improperly in his possession; existing sentence of HL extended 4m. ⁶ |
| June 1853 | Mustered in Huon district, resident with Mr Carroll, Long Bay. ⁹ |
| 15 August 1853 | Husband George Lovell to James Fulton, Coal Mines. ⁶ |
| 1 November 1853 | Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ⁷ |
| 27 June 1854 | Husband George Lovell granted Ticket-of-Leave. ⁶ |
| 29 August 1854 | Conditional Pardon approved (issued at Hobart 1 November 1854). ¹⁰ |
| 4 May 1855 | Husband George Lovell received Certificate of Freedom at Buckland. ⁶ |
| 31 October 1855 | Free by servitude. |
| 6 June 1856 | Enquiry by John Lovell of East Harptree, Bristol re husband George Lovell. ¹¹ |
