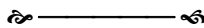
16 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 5pm. ²
c1851	To John Marshall, New Town Rd, Hobart. ³
3 January 1852	Held at Brickfields Hiring Depot prior to court appearance. ³ Tried at Hobart PC charged by her master John Marshall, New Town Rd with absence without leave from his service on the night of 2 January; discharged, no person appearing to prosecute & returned to her service. ⁴
6 January 1852	To Daniel Murphy, Richmond. ³
13 March 1852	To Henry Phillips, Spring Bay. ³
21 August 1852	Application for permission to marry Henry Clark (<i>Nile</i>). ⁵
24 August 1852	Mustered in Swansea district. ³
17 September 1852	Charged by her master Henry Phillips with being absent without leave; sentence 14d SC. ³
21 September 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ³
14 October 1852	Married as under age, spinster, to Henry Clark, full age, servant, bachelor, at St John the Baptist CE Church, Prossers Plains; witnesses John Hutchins & Robert Blackman. ⁶
23 May 1853	Mustered in Spring Bay district. ³
8 September 1853	Son Alfred Clark, labourer's child, born in Spring Bay district; baptised 28 October 1853 in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors James Barden & Caroline Barden. ⁷
4 April 1854	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ³
2 August 1854	Charged with husband Henry Clark with being drunk & disorderly & resisting arrest at Great Swan Port; sentence 1m HL, Henry Clark fined 5s. ^{3,8}
28 November 1854 ^c	Son Thomas Henry Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 6 July 1855 in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors Peter Healy & Ann Dobson. ⁹
20 March 1855	Conditional Pardon approved. ¹⁰
8 March 1856	Free by servitude.

- 12 July 1856^d **Daughter** Jane Clark, labourer's child, born in Spring Bay district; baptised 26 February 1859 in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors Robert Mason & Mary Healy.¹¹
- 24 February 1858^e **Daughter** Margaret Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 21 February 1863,^f registered at St Anne's RC Church, Triabunna; sponsors Mrs Burges & Patrick Cusick.¹²
- 18 September 1860 **Son** Henry Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 21 February 1863,^f registered at St Anne's RC Church, Triabunna; sponsors Mrs Burges & Patrick Cusick.¹³
- 26 October 1862 **Twin sons** Albert & Cornelius Clark, labourer's children, born at Spring Bay; baptised 21 February 1863,^f registered at St Anne's RC Church, Triabunna; sponsors John Bresnan & Margaret Power.¹⁴
- 5 March 1865 **Daughter** Mary Maria Clark, labourer's child, born in Spring Bay district; baptised 11 June 1865 in parish of St Anne's RC Church, Triabunna; sponsors Edward Ryan & Mrs Cusick.¹⁵
- 18 December 1867 **Daughter** Eliza Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 28 October 1868 in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors James Barden & Julia Ryan.¹⁶
- 13 January 1870^g **Son** James Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 9 October 1870 in parish of St Anne's RC Church, Triabunna; sponsors Patrick Ryan & Catherine Cusick.¹⁷
- 3 December 1873 **Son** William Clark, labourer's child, born at Spring Bay; baptised 18 January 1874 in parish of St John's RC Church, Richmond; sponsors John Power & Honorah Power.¹⁸
- 29 April 1876 **Son** William Clark, 2y, died of quinsy at Spring Bay.¹⁹
- 27 May 1881 **Son** Alfred Clark married Caroline Evans at Triabunna.²⁰
- 1 January 1883 **Son** Henry Clark married Alice Howard at St John the Baptist CE Church, Buckland.²¹
- 9 February 1885 **Daughter** Eliza Clark married Richard Pyke at All Saints CE Church, Swansea.²²
- December 1906 **Husband** Henry Clark, 86y, retired, died of dyspepsia & nephritis at Triabunna; buried 17 December at Triabunna CE cemetery.²³
- 3 January 1912 **Died** at Ram Island, Little Swanport; buried 6 January in Buckland CE parish.²⁴
