25 February 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 3:30pm. ²
24 September 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for dysentery (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³
17 June 1851	Tried at Hobart PC charged by her master Simeon Benjamin, Liverpool St, Hobart with absence without leave from her service from the night of 13 June until 16 June; sentence 2m HL, Cascades FF, recommended to be hired in the interior being a country servant. ⁴
c1852	To CW Barr, Launceston. ⁵
12 February 1852	To Launceston FF, then to Robert Cameron, Fingal. ⁵
13 September 1852	Charged by her master Robert Cameron with being in a disorderly house; sentence 2m HL, Launceston FF. ⁵
22 February 1853	To apply in 3 months for Ticket-of-Leave. ⁵
15 April 1853	Application for permission to marry Peter Mulholland (<i>Hyderabad</i> 3) (approved 20 April). ⁶
24 April 1853	To Henry Mylam Cockerill, New Norfolk. ⁵
16 May 1853	Married as 31y, servant, widow, to Peter Mulholland, 24y, labourer, bachelor, at Christ CE Church, Cullenswood; witnesses Robert Cadman & Catherine Cadman. ⁷
19 November 1853 ^d	Son Peter Mulholland, sawyer's child, born at Three Hut Point; baptised 31 March 1854 at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; sponsors Timothy Leary & Ellen McGinly. ⁸
29 November 1853	Husband Peter Mulholland granted Conditional Pardon. ¹⁰
16 October 1854	Husband Peter Mulholland tried at New Norfolk PC, in service to Mr Blythe, ^e charged with misconduct in being drunk on Saturday night; sentence 14d SC. ⁹
7 March 1855	Husband Peter Mulholland charged at New Norfolk with being drunk; fined 20s. ¹⁰
24 April 1855	Contracted as PPH to Henry Mylam Cockerill, New Norfolk at £12 pa. ¹¹
2 May 1855	Husband Peter Mulholland received Certificate of Freedom. ¹⁰

- 10 October 1855^f **Daughter** Mary Mulholland, labourer's child, born at Cullenswood; baptised 22 November 1855 in St Marys district; sponsors Timothy Shughame & Mary Shughame.¹²
- 2 December 1855 Free by servitude.¹³
- 10 April 1857^g **Daughter** Ann Mulholland born in St Marys district; baptised 19 April 1857 in St Marys district; sponsor Father John J Fitzgerald.^{13,14}
- 8 October 1858^h **Son** Richard Mulholland, farmer's child, born in Fingal district; baptised 24 October 1858 in St Marys district; sponsors John Bradley & Anne Smith.^{13,15}
- 17 February 1861 **Died** in Fingal district, wilfully murdered, 36y, labourer's wife.¹⁶
