16 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 3:30pm. <sup>2</sup>
8 July 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for obstipation (off 14 July, cured). <sup>3</sup>
1850	To G Johnston, Liverpool St, Hobart. <sup>4</sup>
16 April 1850	Letter of claim for unpaid wages to CG re G Johnston. <sup>4</sup>
c1851	To Hobart Hospital. <sup>5</sup>
24 March 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. <sup>5</sup>
31 May 1852	To Hobart Hospital. <sup>5</sup>
7 September 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. <sup>5</sup>
23 September 1852	Tried at Hobart PC charged with being drunk in a public place in Hobart on 22 September; fined 5s; Cascades FF. <sup>6</sup>
7 October 1852	To Hobart PO. <sup>5</sup>
1 February 1853	Application for permission to marry Richard Hurley; referred 18 January to PM Richmond (approved 11 February). <sup>7</sup>
15 April 1853	Application for permission to marry William Lewis Hays, free; inform the clergyman. <sup>8</sup>
4 October 1853	Application for permission to marry John Hay, free; will be recommended if clergyman is satisfied. <sup>9</sup>
14 October 1853 <sup>c</sup>	Tried at Hobart PC charged with misconduct in being absent from her authorised place of residence in Barrack St, Hobart on the night of 13 October; sentence 4m HL, Cascades FF. <sup>10</sup>
22 October 1853	Ticket-of-Leave revoked for failing to report to district PO in June. <sup>11</sup>
17 January 1854	Application for permission to marry John Hay, <sup>d</sup> free (refused 18 January). <sup>12</sup>

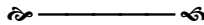
<sup>a</sup> Age given as: 27 years on *Australasia* sick list; 30y on description list.

<sup>b</sup> This was possibly Peter Carrol transported on the *Egyptian 2*; tried at Wexford 7 April 1840 for receiving stolen goods and transported for 7 years. According to the Irish transportation index, Peter Carrol was charged with Thomas Nowlan and Patrick Wickham; Peter Carrol being an old offender, his sentence stood, the other two sentences were reduced to 9m and 6m respectively. All were referred to as 'boys'.

<sup>c</sup> Date given as 17 October 1853 on conduct record.

<sup>d</sup> This was possibly John Hay transported on the *Jupiter 2*; tried at Middlesex 6 September 1832 for stealing from the person, sentenced to 14 years' transportation, 19y, labourer and servant, single.

1 February 1854	To Charles Trappes, Ravens Point. <sup>5</sup>
23 May 1854	Ticket-of-Leave restored. <sup>5</sup>
June 1854	Mustered in Huon district, resident with Anthony S Denne, Bruny Island. <sup>13</sup>
12 June 1854	Application for permission to marry John Hay, free; will be approved if clergyman is satisfied (approved 12 July <sup>e</sup> ). <sup>12</sup>
31 July 1854	Left Huon district for Hobart. <sup>13</sup>
7 August 1854	<b>Married</b> as 42y, servant, spinster to John Hay, 36y, butcher, bachelor, at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; witnesses George Monilaws & Catherine Monilaws (nee Mahon, <i>qv</i> ). <sup>14</sup>
22 January 1856	Free by servitude.
28 January 1856	Certificate of Freedom. <sup>5</sup>
4 December 1859	Husband John Hay, 45y, tripeman, died of rupture of the vena cava & pericardium at Collins St, Hobart. <sup>15</sup>
6 December 1859	Inquest into death of husband John Hay held at Hobart; verdict death from disease of the heart, accelerated by the heat of the day. <sup>16</sup>
27 May 1861 <sup>f</sup>	<b>Married</b> as full age, widow, illiterate, to Thomas Drew, full age, bachelor, at St David's Cathedral, Hobart; witnesses Ellen Brown & Benjamin Hall Brown. <sup>17</sup>
29 December 1862	<b>Died</b> of apoplexy at Francis St, Hobart, 40y, watch maker's wife. <sup>18</sup>
30 December 1862	Inquest held at 8am at the <i>Greyhound Inn</i> , Antill St, Hobart. <sup>19</sup>
