1858	Husband James McHugh occupier of a hut & land (10 acres) at Irish Town near Deloraine. ¹³
22 February 1859	Husband James McHugh tried at Deloraine PC with Martin McGinty charged with assaulting John Armstrong at Irish Town on 21 February; fined 40s & costs. ¹⁴
1 April 1860 ^e	Son James Michael McHugh, farmer's child, born at Irish Town near Deloraine; baptised 29 April 1860 in parish of Holy Trinity RC Church, Westbury; sponsors Martin Collins & Alice Collins. ¹⁵
c1864	Daughter Mary Ann McHugh born. ¹⁶
25 March 1867	Son John Joseph McHugh, farmer's child, born at New Ground. ¹⁷
29 October 1883	Son James McHugh married Elizabeth Payton at St Patrick's RC Church, Latrobe. ¹⁸
5 February 1884	Son Patrick McHugh married Margret Brien at St Patrick's RC Church, Latrobe. ¹⁹
7 September 1887	Daughter Mary Ann McHugh married Edward Sheean at St Patrick's RC Church, Latrobe. ²⁰
19 April 1890 ^f	Died of dropsy in Mersey district, 67y, farmer's wife; buried in RC section, Latrobe Cemetery. ²¹
