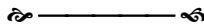

17 October 1848 **Daughter** Mary Kennedy born at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin.²
5 August 1849 Put on *Australasia* sick list for dysentery (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital).³
14 September 1849 Daughter Mary Kennedy put on *Australasia* sick list for tabes.⁴
19 September 1849 Daughter Mary Kennedy, 9m, died of tabes at sea.⁴
11 October 1849 **Died** at Hobart Hospital, 30y.⁵
