14 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 5pm. ²
5 August 1849 ^b	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for obstipation (off 11 August, cured). ³
21 May 1850	Tried at Hobart PC, in service to William Jolly, Kelly St, Hobart, charged with being drunk in a public street in Hobart on 20 May; sentence 1m HL, Cascades FF. ⁴
24 August 1850	Contracted as PPH to John Dalton, Macquarie St, Hobart, 12m at £9 pa. ^{c5}
19 September 1850 ^d	Absconded from the service of Mr Wood, Warwick St, Hobart. ⁶
30 September 1850	Tried at Hobart PC, brought up from 24 September on remand for inquiry to be made, charged with absence without leave from the service of Mrs Wood, Argyle St, Hobart from 4 or 11 September until 23 September when apprehended in the Government Domain, Hobart; sentence 4m HL, Cascades FF, being her first offence, ^e & recommended to be hired in the country being a country servant. ⁷
16 May 1851	Contracted as PPH to Charles Callaghan, Argyle St, Hobart, 12m at £8 pa. ⁵
28 May 1851 ^f	Absconded from the service of Charles Callaghan, Goulburn St, Hobart. ⁹
3 July 1851	Tried at Hobart PC charged with absence without leave from the service of Charles Callaghan, Goulburn St, Hobart from 28 May until 2 July when apprehended; sentence 6m HL, Cascades FF & recommended to be hired in the country being a country servant, vide former recommendation 30 September 1850. ⁷
July 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with singing in the separate apartments; sentence 3d bread & water. ⁸
2 December 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with cutting her sleeve; sentence 14d cleaning the yards. ⁸
9 December 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with not attending to her work; sentence 10d cleaning the yards. ⁸

^a Age given as: 23y on Grangegorman prison register, Irish transportation register and description list; 26y on *Australasia* sick list.

^b This entry has been determined as relating to Jane Loague 1st because of the age given.

^c This could have been Jane Loague 2nd (*qv*).

^d Date given variously as 4 and 11 September 1850 in Hobart lower court records.

^e It seems the magistrate was unaware of her conviction on 21 May 1850.

^f This offence was erroneously entered on the conduct record for Jane Loague 2nd (*qv*). Date also given as 29 May 1851.

19 December 1851	Charged at Cascades FF with having a knife improperly in her possession; sentence 10d cleaning the yards. ⁸
27 January 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. ⁹
15 March 1852	To Launceston FF. ⁹
16 March 1852	To R Marlow, Launceston. ⁹
13 April 1852	Charged by her master R Marlow with being out after hours; sentence 14d SC, Launceston FF. ⁹
29 April 1852	To Agnes Gough, Launceston. ⁹
5 May 1852 ^f	Charged by her mistress Agnes Gough with being drunk; sentence 2m HL, Launceston FF. ⁹
5 July 1852	To Daniel Bowen, Evandale. ⁹
26 August 1852	Charged by her master Daniel Bowen with refusing to work & insolence; sentence 3d SC. ⁹
26 February 1853	Charged by her master Daniel Bowen with drunkenness; sentence 1m HL, Launceston FF. ⁹
22 March 1853	To Daniel Bowen, Evandale. ⁹
18 April 1853	Application for permission to marry Francis Watts (<i>Asia</i> 5); recommended if clergyman is satisfied (refused 1 June). ¹⁰
29 August 1853	Charged with absence without leave; sentence 3m HL. ⁹
30 August 1853	To Launceston FF. ⁹
14 November 1853	To William Burston, Launceston. ⁹
12 December 1853	Charged with being drunk & neglect of duty; sentence 2m HL, Launceston FF. ⁹
30 January 1854	To William Gilbert, Launceston. ⁹
13 February 1854	Charged with being drunk; sentence 7d SC, Launceston FF. ⁹
21 February 1854	To William Gilbert, Launceston. ⁹
28 February 1854	Charged with drunkenness; sentence 3m HL, Launceston FF. ⁹
15 May 1854	To Daniel Bowen, Launceston. ⁹
9 August 1854	Tried at Evandale PC charged with being drunk, fined 5s. ¹¹
17 August 1854	Tried at Evandale PC charged with being drunk & out after hours; sentence 6m HL. ¹¹
21 August 1854	To Launceston FF. ⁹
20 November 1854	To Cascades FF, Hobart. ⁹
13 January 1855	To Joseph Hone, Macquarie St, Hobart. ⁹
8 February 1855	Charged with being absent & under the influence of liquor; sentence 3m HL, Cascades FF. ⁹
30 May 1855	To R Hart, Brisbane St, Hobart. ⁹
19 June 1855 ^f	Charged with being drunk & out after hours; sentence 9m HL, Cascades FF. ⁹
16 February 1856 ^g	Tried at Hobart PC charged with misconduct in being out after hours between 12 & 1 o'clock this morning & using obscene language; discharged. ¹²
9 April 1856	Free by servitude.
21 April 1856	Certificate of Freedom collected. ⁹
22 April 1856	Tried at Hobart PC charged with disturbing the public peace in a public street in Hobart on 21 April; fined 5s, in default 10d imprisonment, Cascades FF. ¹²
26 April 1856	Tried at Hobart PC charged with being drunk in a public street in Hobart on 25 April; fined £1, in default 7d imprisonment, Cascades FF. ¹²
5 May 1856	Tried at Hobart PC charged with using obscene language in a public street in Hobart on the morning of 4 May; fined 5s & to pay costs 1s, in default 14d imprisonment, Cascades FF. ¹³

^g Date given as 15 February 1856 on conduct record.

- 23 June 1856 Tried at Hobart PC charged with being drunk in a public street in Hobart on 21 June; fined £2 being 2nd offence, in default 14d imprisonment, Cascades FF.¹³
- 18 September 1856 Tried at Hobart PC charged with being drunk in a public street in Hobart; fined £3 being 3rd offence, in default 14d SC.¹⁴
- 25 March 1857 Tried at Hobart PC charged with being drunk in a public street in Hobart on 24 March; fined £4 being her 4th offence.¹⁵
