

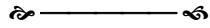

14 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 12 noon. ²
15 August 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for dysuria (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³
18 June 1850	Tried at Hobart PC charged with absence without leave from the service of Mr McQuinn, Collins St, Hobart from 4 June until 17 June; sentence 6m HL, Cascades FF, recommended that half that term be passed in the separate apartments & then to be hired in the interior. ⁴
28 June 1851	Application for permission to marry William Frampton, free; ^b referred 8 July to PM Fingal & 22 July to PM Longford (approved 12 August). ⁵
26 August 1851	Charged with drunkenness whilst in service to the Crown; sentence 10d SC. ⁷
8 September 1851	Married as 28y, servant, spinster, to William Frampton, 38y, labourer, bachelor, at St Andrew's CE Church, Carrick; witnesses Mary Collins & C Turner. ⁶
9 March 1853	Mustered in Westbury district. ⁷
29 March 1853	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁷
6 June 1853	Tried at Deloraine PC charged with being drunk at Deloraine on 4 June; reprimanded. ⁸
7 June 1853	Tried at Deloraine PC charged with being drunk at Deloraine on 6 June; sentence 3m HL, Launceston FF & recommended Ticket-of-Leave be revoked. ⁸
11 August 1853	To Launceston FF. ⁷
14 August 1853	To husband William Frampton. ⁷
5 October 1853	Tried at Deloraine PC charged with misconduct in being in the district without a pass on 4 October; reprimanded. ⁸
10 January 1854	Mustered in Westbury district. ⁷
11 February 1854	Tried at Westbury PC charged with being drunk in a public street at Westbury on 10 February; 24h SC. ⁹
9 June 1854	Mustered at Carrick, resident at Westbury. ¹⁰
8 August 1854	Moved from Longford district. ¹⁰

^a Age given as 23y on Grangegorman prison register.

^b This may have been William Frampton alias Bartlett transported on the *Argyle* in 1831, but he was aged 29 in 1831 and he was married.

7 December 1855	Charged with being drunk; fined 20s. ⁷
1 March 1856	Free by servitude.
20 March 1856	Certificate of Freedom to Westbury. ⁷
