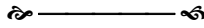

6 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 4pm. ²		
25 February 1851	Application for permission to marry Patrick Kelly, free; referred 1 March to M McGregor, Elizabeth St, Hobart ^b & 7 March PM Hobart (refused 15 April, unable to support a wife). ³		
11 October 1851	Application for permission to marry John Daley (approved 4 November). ⁴		
1 December 1851	Married as 30y, servant, widow, to John Daley, 45y, labourer, bachelor, at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; witnesses John Coghlin & Margaret Coghlin. ⁵		
27 July 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁶		
December 1852	Mustered in Huon district, resident at Pinchey's Bay. ⁷		
21 December 1852	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ⁶		
26 May 1853	Son John Daley born; baptised 31 July 1853 at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; sponsors William Dwyer & Elizabeth Dwyer. ⁸		
June 1853	Mustered in Huon district, resident with husband at Franklin. ⁷		
29 November 1853	Conditional Pardon approved (issued at Franklin 16 June 1854). ⁹		
December 1853	Mustered in Huon district, resident at Franklin. ⁷		
26 November 1854	Daughter Ann Daley, farmer's child, born in Hobart district; baptised 3 December 1854 at St Joseph's RC Church, Hobart; sponsors Denis Ryan & Mary Kinsella. ¹⁰		
2 April 1856	Free by servitude.		
16 September 1856	Son Cornelius Daley born in Franklin district; baptised 21 September 1856 in Huon district; sponsors Jeremiah Dwyer & Bridget Riggs. ¹¹		
1858	Husband John Daley occupier of a house & land (40 acres) at Franklin. ¹²		
2 August 1871	Husband John Daley, 70y, farmer, died of asthma at Franklin. ¹³		
3 June 1878	Married as 61y, servant, widow, to Patrick Holloway, 60y, farmer, widower, at St Mary's RC Cathedral, Hobart; witnesses Peter Larkin & Mary Larkin. ¹⁴		
4 September 1887	Husband Patrick Holloway, 76y, farmer, died of old age at Port Cygnet. ¹⁵		
18 December 1893	Admitted to New Town Invalid Depot from Hobart (discharged 22 April 1898 at own request). ¹⁶		
1 September 1898	Discharged ^c from New Town Invalid Depot at own request. ¹⁷		

^a Age given as 25y on Grangegorman prison register.

^b M McGregor may have been Ellen's employer.

4 July 1899

Died of senilis at New Town Charitable Institution, 83y, servant; buried 5 July in pauper section, Cornelian Bay Cemetery, Hobart.¹⁸
