13 September 1849 **Son** J Foy born on board the *Australasia*.³
14 September 1849 Put on *Australasia* sick list for parturition (off 3 October, sent to *Anson*).³
29 September 1849 Son J Foy put on *Australasia* sick list for debility.⁴
1 October 1849 Son J Foy died on board *Australasia*, 18d, of debility.⁴
19 October 1850 **Died** at Cascades FF, 31y, PPH.⁵
