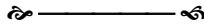

16 April 1849      Son Jeremiah Neill, 1m, died at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin.<sup>2</sup>  
10 August 1849      Put on *Australasia* sick list for dysentery (off 25 August, cured).<sup>3</sup>  
30 August 1849      Put on *Australasia* sick list for dysentery.<sup>3</sup>  
14 September 1849      Son Michael Neill put on *Australasia* sick list for tabes.<sup>4</sup>  
15 September 1849      Son Michael Neill died at sea, 6m, of tabes.<sup>4</sup>  
22 September 1849      **Died** of dysentery at sea, 28y.<sup>3</sup>
