

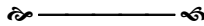

2 October 1848	Received at Grangegorman Depot, Dublin at 10am. ²
21 September 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for dysentery (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³
2 August 1850	Charged at Ross FF with having meal bread & potatoes improperly in her possession; sentence 14d SC. ⁴
15 October 1850	Mustered in Longford district. ⁴
18 January 1851	Contracted as PPH to John Bounday, Campbell Town, 12m at £7 pa. ⁵
12 April 1851	Charged with bringing out a quantity of snuff, concealed, from Ross FF; sentence 4d SC. ⁴
14 May 1851	Charged at Ross FF with making a false statement; sentence 6m HL, Ross FF. ⁴
7 June 1851	Charged at Ross FF with insubordination; sentence 6d SC. ⁴
27 November 1851	Tried at Campbell Town PC charged by her mistress Mrs Job Padfield with disobedience of orders, using abusive language towards her & being absent without leave this morning; sentence 3m HL, Ross FF. ⁶
23 January 1852	Sponsor at baptism of Mary Quinn, daughter of Mary Quinn, at Ross FF. ⁷
26 March 1852	To James Soper, <i>Bath Inn</i> , Oatlands. ⁴
29 June 1852	To apply in 3 months for Ticket-of-Leave. ⁴
27 August 1852	To John Bayly, Oatlands. ⁴
18 January 1853	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁴
24 December 1853	Daughter Catherine Bond, labourer's child, born in Oatlands district; baptised 30 December 1853 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsors Thomas Bond & Catherine LeFevre (nee Doherty, <i>qv</i>). ⁸
4 April 1854	Ticket-of-Leave revoked, absent from muster December 1853. ⁹
25 April 1854	Ticket-of-Leave restored. ⁴
5 June 1854	Mustered in Oatlands district. ⁴
13 June 1854	Application for permission to marry Charles Bond, FS (<i>Sir George Seymour</i>); will be approved if clergyman is satisfied (approved 5 July ^b). ¹⁰
31 July 1854	Married as 32y, housemaid, to Charles Bond, 32y, labourer, at St Peter's CE Church, Oatlands; witnesses Michael Milligan & Catherine Dixon. ¹¹

18 April 1855	Free by servitude.
2 September 1855	Daughter Elizabeth Bond, labourer's child, born at Oatlands; baptised 30 September 1855 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsors Ann[?] Tully ^c & Ellen Dempsey. ¹²
23 October 1855	Daughter Elizabeth Bond, 2m, labourer's child, died of convulsions at home in Oatlands district. ¹³
14 June 1857	Daughter Mary Ann Bond, labourer's child, born at Jericho; baptised 9 July 1857 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsor Kate Dixon. ¹⁴
1858	Husband Charles Bond occupier with George Reeves of an agricultural farm (20 acres) at Jericho. ¹⁵
10 April 1859	Daughter Laura Maria Bond, labourer's child, born at Jericho; baptised 22 May 1859 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsors James Marshal & Mary McKean. ¹⁶
14 April 1861 ^d	Son Charles William Bond, labourer's child, born at Oatlands; baptised 28 April 1861 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsors Patrick Clark & Catherine Hall. ¹⁷
6 May 1863	Daughter Alice Margaret Bond, labourer's child, born at Jericho; baptised 14 June 1864 at St Paul's RC Church, Oatlands; sponsors John Mears & May Tibbs. ¹⁸
31 January 1870	Daughter Catherine Bond married William John Lewis at Presbyterian Free Manse, Oatlands. ¹⁹
8 May 1876	Daughter Mary Ann Bond married William Linnell at Presbyterian Free Manse, Oatlands. ²⁰
9 September 1882	Son Charles William Bond married Grace Harbuckle at St Mary the Virgin CE Church, Macquarie Plains. ²¹
23 July 1887	Son Charles William Bond, 26y, labourer, died at Hobart Hospital of disease of knee joint & spine. ²²
31 December 1895	Daughter Alice Margaret Bond married Francis Roland Allen at Presbyterian Free Manse, Oatlands. ²³
7 January 1897	Husband Charles Bond, 75y, labourer, died of senility at <i>Woodbanks</i> , Oatlands. ²⁴
20 November 1907	Died of senility at daughter Alice's residence, Mount Seymour, 80y, labourer's widow. ²⁵
