- Application for permission to marry James Herkes (*Frances Charlotte*) sent to the Muster Master.¹²
- 7 October 1842 Application for permission to marry James Herkes sent to the Secretary; not approved, woman's conduct must be amended.¹²
- 16 November 1842 Charged with disobedience of orders;¹³ sentence 24 hours in solitary confinement.⁸
- 11 January 1843 Returned to Government, to the Police Office, Evandale, at her master's request; in the service of Mr Henry Glover.¹⁴
- 22 February 1843 Application for permission to marry James Herkes (*Frances Charlotte*) sent to the Muster Master.¹⁵
- 7 March 1843 Application for permission to marry James Herkes sent to the Secretary; not approved.¹⁵
- 14 March 1843 Returned to Government, to the Police Office, Evandale, at her master's request; in the service of Mr Fall.¹⁶
- 27 March 1843 Charged at Launceston Female Factory with insubordination in the Crime Class; sentence 12 months imprisonment and hard labour, 3 months of which period to be served in solitary confinement, and recommended that this sentence be carried into effect at Launceston Gaol.⁸
- 24 July 1843 Charged at Launceston Gaol with insubordination; existing sentence of transportation extended 2 years and recommended to be removed to Longford Gaol under her present sentence of hard labour.⁸
- 19 December 1843 Charged at Longford Gaol with misconduct; admonished.⁸
- January 1844 Ordered to serve further probation previous to being classified.⁸
