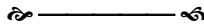
21 May 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot at 3:30pm. ²
29 July 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for obstipation (off 6 August, cured). ³
19 August 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for cynanche (off 29 September, sent to Hobart Hospital). ³
21 February 1851	Tried at Hobart PC charged by her master Mr Ladd, Brisbane St, Hobart with insolence to her mistress on 20 February; admonished at request of her master & returned to her service. ⁴
3 November 1851	Contracted as PPH to Miss Mary A Dixon, Davey St, Hobart, 12m at £8 pa. ⁵
22 March 1853	Tried at Hobart PC charged with misconduct in the service of Miss Mary A Dixon, Davey St, Hobart, given into custody by her mistress; discharged to her service, no prosecutor appearing. ⁴
21 December 1853	To Cascades FF, Hobart. ⁶
22 December 1853	Tried at Hobart PC charged by Mr Evans on behalf of her mistress Miss Mary A Dixon, Davey St, Hobart with misconduct in being out after hours at 9:30pm on 20 December; sentence 3m HL. ⁴
9 March 1854	To Miss Mary A Dixon, Davey St, Hobart. ⁶
3 October 1854	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ⁶
3 January 1855 ^a	Application for permission to marry James Mooney ^b (<i>Blenheim</i> 4) (approved same day). ⁷
6 March 1855	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ⁶
1 September 1855	Tried at Hobart PC with James Mooney (<i>Blenheim</i> 4) charged with larceny under the value of £5 in stealing on or about 20 August 1 silk handkerchief, value 4s; both discharged. ⁸ Charged also with larceny under the value of £5 in feloniously stealing on or about 20 August 1 silk pocket handkerchief, value 4s, property of Henry Morrisby, & James Mooney charged with feloniously receiving the said silk pocket handkerchief well knowing it to be stolen as aforesaid; case dismissed. ⁸
4 September 1855	Tried at Hobart PC charged with larceny under the value of £5 in feloniously stealing in the month of August 1 pair of cloth boots, value 6s, 1 piece silk handkerchief, value 15s, & 1 artificial flower, value 8s, property of Messieurs Sly & Risby & further

charged with receiving the same well knowing them to be stolen; sentence 18m HL, Cascades FF.^{6,8}

- 29 September 1855 Ticket-of-Leave revoked for misconduct.⁹
- 1 October 1856 Contracted as PPH to Charles W Hall, Elizabeth St, Hobart, at £9 pa.¹⁰
- 21 October 1856 To Cascades Gaol, then to Mrs Scott, New Town Rd, Hobart.⁶
- 13 January 1857 Ticket-of-Leave restored.⁶
- 8 July 1857 Tried at Hobart PC charged with larceny under £5 in stealing 1 handkerchief, value 8s, & 2s, property & monies of Ann Hicks (nee Behan, *qv*) on 6 July at Hobart; discharged.
- Charged also with absconding from her authorised place of residence with Mrs Ann Hicks (nee Behan, *qv*), Davey St, Hobart on 5 July & remaining at large until apprehended on 7 July; discharged.¹¹
- 4 August 1857 Conditional Pardon granted.⁶
- 18 April 1864 Free by servitude.
