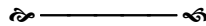

19 April 1849	Received at Grangegorman Depot at 9:30am. <sup>2</sup>		
11 July 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for cynanche (off 14 July, cured). <sup>3</sup>		
23 September 1849	Put on <i>Australasia</i> sick list for dysentery (off 2 October, cured). <sup>3</sup>		
5 March 1851	Contracted as PPH to William Duffy, Warwick St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. <sup>4</sup>		
1 December 1851	Tried at Hobart PC charged by her master John D Thane, Macquarie St, Hobart with absence without leave from her service on 30 November for about 2 hours & with insolence to her mistress on her return; pleaded guilty of absence without leave only; charges withdrawn & returned to her service. <sup>5</sup>		
8 December 1851	Contracted as PPH to William Duffy, Warwick St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. <sup>4</sup>		
2 January 1852	Application for permission to marry William Sampson ( <i>Moffatt</i> 3); referred 8 January to PM Hobart, put away, man declines the marriage. <sup>6</sup>		
8 January 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. <sup>7</sup>		
15 January 1852	Contracted as PPH to William Duffy, Warwick St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. <sup>4</sup>		
9 February 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. <sup>7</sup>		
	Contracted as PPH to Mary Horwood, Liverpool St, <sup>a</sup> Hobart, 12m at £8 pa. <sup>8</sup>		
9 March 1852	To Brickfields Hiring Depot, Hobart. <sup>7</sup>		
17 March 1852	To John Nelson, Sorell. <sup>7</sup>		
19 March 1852	Absconded from the service of John Nelson of Sorell. <sup>9</sup>		
1 April 1852	Tried at Hobart PC, brought up from 24 & 30 March on remand at Cascades FF for inquiry, charged with absconding from the service of John Nelson, Pittwater; discharged, there being no proof of the offence, returned to Brickfields Hiring Depot. <sup>5</sup>		
6 April 1852	To Launceston FF. <sup>7</sup>		
12 April 1852	To James Innes, Launceston. <sup>7</sup>		
29 June 1852	To Launceston district. <sup>7</sup>		
3 August 1852	To apply in 1 month for Ticket-of-Leave. <sup>7</sup>		
21 September 1852	Ticket-of-Leave granted. <sup>7</sup>		
31 December 1852	Application for permission to marry Thomas Hall ( <i>Cressy</i> 1). <sup>10</sup>		
c1853	<b>Married</b> <sup>b</sup> Thomas Hall in Launceston. <sup>10</sup>

5 July 1853	Husband Thomas Hall granted Conditional Pardon. <sup>11</sup>
11 March 1854 <sup>c</sup>	<b>Son</b> John Thomas Hall, labourer's child, born at Paterson St, Launceston; baptised 26 March 1854 at St Joseph's RC Church, Launceston; sponsor Michael Moore. <sup>12</sup>
17 March 1856	Free by servitude.
28 March 1856	Certificate of Freedom to Launceston for collection. <sup>7</sup>
21 October 1856 <sup>d</sup>	<b>Son</b> Francis Robert Hall, hay presser's child, born at Launceston; baptised 14 December 1856 at St Joseph's RC Church, Launceston; sponsors Daniel Howard & Margaret Davis <sup>e</sup> . <sup>13</sup>
20 July 1860	Unnamed son _ Hall, 1h, labourer's child, died of premature labour at Launceston. <sup>14</sup>
31 August 1860	Unnamed <b>son</b> <sup>f</sup> _ Hall, labourer's child, born at Launceston. <sup>15</sup>
23 August 1861	<b>Son</b> James Hall, labourer's child, born at Launceston. <sup>16</sup>
23 July 1863	<b>Daughter</b> Margaret Hall, labourer's child, born at York St, Launceston; baptised 23 August 1863 at St Joseph's RC Church, Launceston; sponsor Mary Lahey. <sup>17</sup>
2 July 1876	Son John Thomas Hall married Cecilia Dennis at St Peter's CE Church, St Leonards. <sup>18</sup>
10 October 1881	Witness with husband Thomas Hall at marriage of son James Hall to Emma Jane White at York St Baptist Church, Launceston. <sup>19</sup>
8 August 1883	Son Francis Robert Hall married Elizabeth Ann Henson at St Paul's CE Church, Launceston. <sup>20</sup>
16 December 1884	Son Francis Robert Hall, 28y, labourer, died of phthisis at Launceston. <sup>21</sup>
31 July 1886	Husband Thomas Hall, 58y, labourer, died of internal cancer at Brisbane St west, Launceston; funeral left his late residence Brisbane St west, Launceston at 3pm on 1 August. <sup>22</sup>
3 August 1886	<b>Died</b> of bronchitis at Brisbane St west, Launceston, 57y, widow; funeral left her late residence Brisbane St west, Launceston at 3pm on 5 August. <sup>23</sup>
