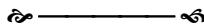

17 December 1850	Contracted as PPH to William Livingstone, Liverpool St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. ⁴
6 May 1851	Contracted as PPH to George Dudfield, Melville St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. ⁵
31 May 1851	Contracted as PPH to George Dudfield, Melville St, Hobart, 12m at £7 pa. ⁵
9 July 1851	Application for permission to marry George Yates (<i>Eden</i> 3); referred 11 July to PM, woman did not wish the memorial to be approved according a letter in possession of PM. ⁶
c1851	Daughter Grace Moore born. ²⁰
19 September 1851	Application for permission to marry George Moore (<i>Equestrian</i> 1); referred 19 September to Superintendent, Brickfields Hiring Depot. ⁷
18 October 1851	Application for permission to marry George Moore (<i>Equestrian</i> 1) (approved 28 October). ⁷
24 November 1851	Married as 22y, spinster, to George Moore, 34y, labourer, bachelor, at St John's CE Church, New Town; witnesses George Gee & Isabella Hutchison. ⁸
5 December 1851	Letter of claim for unpaid wages to CG re George Dudfield. ⁹
16 November 1852	Husband George Moore granted Conditional Pardon. ¹⁰
27 November 1852	Son Robert Joseph Moore, gardener's child, born at New Town. ¹¹
8 February 1853	Ticket-of-Leave granted. ¹²
10 October 1854	Recommended for Conditional Pardon. ¹²
14 August 1855	Conditional Pardon approved (issued at Hobart 12 November). ¹³
c1856	Married George Hare ^c . ¹⁴
12 April 1856	Free by servitude.
16 April 1856	Certificate of Freedom collected. ¹²

- 16 August 1857 **Daughter** Mary Ann Hare, labourer's child, born at New Town.¹⁴
1858 Husband George Hare occupier of a cottage at New Town (<1 acre).¹⁵
- 27 March 1859 **Son** Henry Carpenter Hare, labourer's child, born at New Town.¹⁶
- 25 September 1866 **Son** John James Hare, labourer's child, born at Queen St, Hobart.¹⁷
- 31 March 1868 Tried at Hobart PC for assault & using indecent language; fined 5s & costs for using indecent language, in default 7d HL, & fined 5s & costs for assault, in default 14d HL, Cascades Gaol (discharged w/e 22 April).¹⁸
- 24 June 1869 Daughter Mary Ann Hare, 12y, labourer's child, died of typhoid fever at Queen St, Hobart.¹⁹
- 31 August 1870 Daughter Grace Moore married Philip Glock at 287 Liverpool St, Hobart.²⁰
- 1 June 1876 Witness at marriage of son Robert Joseph Moore to Harriet Martha Smillie at St David's Cathedral, Hobart.²¹
- 19 September 1878 Witness at marriage of son Henry Carpenter Hare to Maria Gillaspie at 287 Liverpool St, Hobart.²²
- 16 May 1888 Son John James Hare married Lily Bertha Skinner at Chalmers Presbyterian Manse, Hobart.²³
- 3 January 1891 Husband George Hare, 79y, labourer, died of senility at Hobart Hospital; buried 5 January in CE section, Cornelian Bay Cemetery, Hobart; last residence Harrington St, Hobart.²⁴
- 19 November 1891 Admitted to New Norfolk Insane Asylum being of unsound mind & suffering from delusional insanity due to family troubles, 60y, fair bodily condition, illness of 10m duration, widow, resident at Hobart, household duties, by private order of son Robert Joseph Moore.²⁵
- 15 September 1906 **Died** of general debility at New Norfolk Insane Asylum; private funeral; buried with husband George Hare in CE section, Cornelian Bay Cemetery, Hobart.²⁶
